Applications available to seniors for Networks Scholarships

MUNCIE -- Networks Financial Institute at Indiana State University is accepting applications for the 2006 class of Networks Scholars.

The scholarships are awarded to incoming freshman who declare a major or minor through Indiana State University's college of Business and intend to pursue careers in the financial services industry. Each Networks scholar receives a four-year \$20,000 scholarship to support the cost of tuition and fees, a \$3,000 professional development account, and a new, wireless laptop computer.

Scholars also will participate in extensive professional development including coursework, access to at least one paid internship, an opportunity for an international experience, an Indiana State University faculty mentor during freshman and sophomore years, and an executive mentor during junior and senior years.

High school seniors interested in applying for a Networks Scholarship must complete and return their application to Networks Scholars Selection Committee by Dec. 2.
